From the Staff at River's Edge Haven of Hope

On the heels of summer 2024, it's been a common sentiment from many that it went too quickly! We reflect on our summer here at the farm in awe and gratitude; we could never have imagined the blessings we would receive on all our planning and organizing. Proverbs 19:21 reminds us, "Many are the plans in a man's heart, but it is the LORD's purpose that prevails."

Shortly before our summer plans got underway, we put out a plea for donations of snacks and beverages to assist with associated costs. Our programs are free and the donations we receive go a long way in keeping costs manageable. Once again, we were overwhelmed by the generous and loving response we received from our community and the generosity of our Founders who allowed us to use their property and facilities. We also cannot overlook the gift of time that we received in the form of volunteer mentors and volunteers (adult and youth alike). Thank you!

Between the DYIC Monday day camps, Wednesdays of mentoring; our activity camps, and Streetlight Ministries "Bright Hope" camp, River's Edge Haven of Hope (REHH) hosted over 300 youths this summer! The property was abuzz with joyful sounds of laughter and excitement. With firm conviction, we confess that God was with us and blessed us richly! Not a single injury occurred and despite the wet summer we experienced, not a single day of activities was negatively impacted by the weather. Remarkably, one storm passed over during lunch with Streetlight's Bright Hope Camp and cleared just in time for devotions around the fire pit. Thunder rumbled in the distance like a reminder that our plans are not our own.

With the approach of the fall season, school and regular routines have begun again. The same holds for REHH—with some exciting new additions! We welcome a new part-time staff member, Hannah Vermeulen. Hannah is no stranger to us at REHH; she has been a regular volunteer over the last few years and also works next door in the strawberry operation. Next, a Wednesday 8:00 AM "early-bird" mentoring timeslot was added this summer in the hopes that it would allow more men to join our team of mentors. With the overall success of that timeslot, we have implemented it into our regular 11-week program. We have started our first-ever youth group called "Hope Alive". "Hope Alive" is an extension of our one-on-one mentoring program. Older youths who have been mentored in the past are invited to come and spend intentional time together working on social skills, cooperation, and building healthy relationships. The youth who come to "Hope Alive" help prepare and share a meal together; they participate in discussions on scripture that teach us about the hope we have in Jesus and how we have been made alive through Him and enjoy a group activity. Finally, we are the thankful recipients of a woodworking shop! A work associate of one of our mentors made the donation after their father's passing. We can't wait to get it all set up so that we can put it to good use. We have so much to be thankful for!

We covet your prayers so that we can continue sharing the hope, love, and saving grace of our Saviour with the youth who enter here. May God's purposes prevail to His glory!
