POOF!! And just like that, summer is over! The

adage "Time flies when you're having fun" has been proven true once again. As in the past, we were blessed to host the Dunnville Youth Impact Centre on Mondays for their "Mission POSSIBLE" day camp. We also got to participate by planning and executing different woods and horse activities. The horse activities were a bit of a challenge this year as our herd is aging and ailing, but thankfully, two staff members imported their own horses to the farm for a portion of the summer.

The hot humid days did not deter

Streetlight Ministries brought just over 100 participants, leaders, and volunteers for the 5th

> anniversary of "Bright Hope" camp at River's Edge. At the end of our three days together, Streetlight presented us with a banner to commemorate our partnership. We held five of our own day camps at the farm this summer: auto mechanics, horsemanship,

sports, art, and water activities. New this the youth year, the auto mechanics camp was planned and led by Mr. Mike Koetsier of Round 2 Tires. The youths learned the

> main components of a lawnmower and raced against the clock, and each other, to put the mowers back together.

> Working in teams, the youths also learned how to change a spare tire and finished the day with a used tire obstacle course. The hot, humid days did not deter the youths from having fun!

> Wednesdays were set aside for one-on-one mentoring - the focus at River's Edge year-round. Our summer mentoring block is our shortest and most challenging to plan, but with the help of

our volunteer mentors, we were able to mentor 10 youths for eight weeks.

On Thursdays, we held our youth volunteer days. We had eight weeks of help from 17 highschool-aged youth who collectively donated a total of 309.5 volunteer hours! We were blessed to watch these young people get to know each other, forge new friendships, and work together. Volunteers are fundamental and foundational to everything that we do at River's Edge! It is impossible to accurately count the number of people who selflessly serve this ministry in various ways. At the outset of the summer, we wondered how we were going to manage the mentoring and all of our planned activities because we had so few committed volunteers. The Lord humbled us each week by supplying helpful hearts and hands at the perfect time. We were challenged to practically apply to ourselves the very lessons we were trying to teach the youths through our theme based on 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, "Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, be thankful in all circumstances". While explaining to the youths that Philippians 4:4-7 is a parallel verse to our theme text, we were reminded in verses 6 and 7. "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus". The youths offered examples of times and circumstances in which they have experienced anxiety or stress, and

together we thanked God that He is always near, and no matter what we're going through, there are things to be thankful for. With the Lord's blessing, this Fall, we will continue to focus on one-on-one mentoring while also hosting curriculum-related school visits, tours, and weekly visits from our friends from the various Anchor homes. Our Hope Alive Youth group, which consists of older male and female youths, will be put on hold for the Fall block while we look for a male and female tag team to facilitate this group. Our ability to mentor children and youths depends entirely on the number of volunteer mentors we have each block. We are so thankful for our volunteers! Please prayerfully consider joining our team of mentors so that we can share the love, hope, and joy of Christ with the children waiting to get into the mentoring program. As we move into a new season, we are encouraged and comforted knowing that "Our help is in the name of the LORD" (Ps. 121). In His service.
