## At the Farm this Summer

We are very excited to be hosting and holding a number of groups and events at the farm this summer!

For the 4th consecutive year, both the Dunnville Youth Impact Centre and Streetlight Ministries will be joining us here at the farm. As in the past, the DYIC will be running their day camp on Monday afternoons for the entire summer (holidays excepted) and Streetlight Ministries will be bringing a cheery busload of 50 happy daycampers for 3 consecutive days in July. These camps bring so much life and joy to the property. As hosts of these groups, we are blessed to participate alongside the youth in various ways, expanding the opportunities to connect with youth through the ministry at River's Edge.

We also have a number of "firsts" at the farm this year! On Tuesday afternoons we will be holding "Volunteer Days". Alongside adult volunteers, youth—in particular those who need community hours—will help around the farm by doing chores and farm related work. On Wednesdays, from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM, we will be holding mentoring sessions. This is a great way to get some of the youth, who have been on the waitlist, into the program and be able to mentor some of our existing youth who will benefit from ongoing

support. As you can imagine, summer can be complicated for scheduling so we are very thankful and excited to have 11 willing volunteer mentors available to walk alongside these young people. Finally, each Thursday of the summer (except 2) River's Edge will host 25 youths aged 8-14 for "Activity Day Camps". Each Thursday will be a different activity: art, woodworking, sports, water activities, woods, and horsemanship. Our summer programs are free so we rely heavily on the generosity of our community and program participants to bring a snack or drink to share. Please keep us in mind when you are baking or out shopping, we would thankfully accept any contributions you can make for the benefit of our program participants.

The planning does not stop with summer camps and activities—preparations for our Fall block of sessions are already underway. With the Lord's blessing, we will begin our regular mentoring sessions on September 9th. We daily see God's hand in providing River's Edge as a place to minister to youth and the broader community. The Lord continues to bless the ministry here at River's Edge and we covet your prayers and ongoing support.
