

From the Staff at River's Edge

On the calendar the official start of spring was March 21st; almost 2 months into the season, we can now see the signs. The baby animals on the farm, returning birds, the fresh green leaves, trilliums, and ferns in the forest all herald the season and testify of God's providential care. We were able to host our very first "Mom & Tots" drop-in. Every other Wednesday, from mid-December to early March, the barn was open to mothers with children under 5 years, to come and enjoy a change of scenery and spend a couple of hours in fellowship with other moms. After the hustle and bustle of the Christmas season, winter

can be long and lonely. The drop-in was appreciated by those who attended.

The Hope Alive youth group, which is an extension of our mentoring program, also went well over the winter and has continued into spring. This program has been blessed with support and generosity through meals donated by community members who signed up through our MealTrain (which can be found on our website). These donations help alleviate the cost of the program and allow the youth participants to experience a sit-down family meal, complete with devotions—and oftentimes, dessert!

Just before Christmas, we sent out a request for donations for "meal" and "baking" jars; which would be gifted to the mentees and their families at our Christmas dinner. Our request received an overwhelming response! We received so many beautifully decorated jars and were able to send each family home with a meal and baking jar to prepare together over the holidays. 110 people at our Christmas dinner and had some jars left over to use in our kitchen program.

God's blessings over the ministry at River's Edge continue to encourage and inspire! During the March Break, River's Edge hosted a two day "Boots 'n' Roots" camp in partnership with the DYIC (Dunnville Youth Impact Centre). The scriptural focus of the camp was based on Ephesians 3:17 "...being rooted and established in love." On separate days, 24 girls and 24 boys came to the farm and spent time doing activities and devotions that focused on demonstrating God's love—an upbuilding way to end the March break.

Streetlight Ministries has visited River's Edge with children from inner-city Hamilton for the past four summers in connection with their "Bright Hope" summer camp. This past March, we were able to host a group from Streetlight for the first time during the winter! It was so nice to spend time with our friends from Streetlight—albeit with a scaled-down group—ahead of the busy summer.

Recently, the Board and Staff of River's Edge hosted a volunteer appreciation evening. It was a fun and relaxing evening and a real eye-opener in terms of taking physical count of the many volunteerswho have kept River's Edge open and running for another year. The physical count doesn't take into account the multitude of people who support this ministry in their prayers, through donations of food, supplies and financially. There is always the risk of leaving someone out when extending "thanks", so from all of us at River's Edge, thank you all, for your continued support and encouragement.

Time is a precious commodity, and we need Christian adults willing to spend intentional, quality time with a child or youth once a week for 11 weeks during the fall, winter, and spring—our summer block is shorter, at a maximum of 8 weeks. God has answered our prayers for more mentors, and we are thankful for the Holy Spirit who has worked in the hearts of Bert Vis, Owen Pols, Brad Schutten, and Caleb Vermeulen to join our mentoring team. Some of our volunteer mentors can only help for the summer, and some can help indefinitely, but our waitlist is directly affected by the number of volunteer mentors. Experience the blessing of sharing the love and hope of Christ with a child or youth.

If you have a heart for the ministry at River's Edge and have a talent for organizing events, River's Edge needs you too! Two of our committee members are retiring after 4 years of dedicated support and service. The River's Edge fundraising committee holds 2 to 3 events annually.
